

MAA AMERICAN SPONTOON

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION SHEET

INCLUDED: MAA American Spontoon head, wood shaft, 2 YOU WILL NEED: Drill, 1/32" drill bit, Phillips Head screw bit, and a hand saw.



To assemble your MAA American Spontoon:

(A) You will need to saw off approximately 1 3/4 inches off of the tenon of the shaft. This will make the shaft fit more snugly to the head.



(B) Take the head and fit it tightly on to the shaft. Then use an

awl or scribe to mark the shaft through the pre-drilled holes in the head. After you have done this, remove the Spontoon head and drill a shallow hole using a 1/32" (approx.) drill bit. [Fig.2]

(C) When the hole has been drilled, you can put the Spontoon head back in place



(D) Line up the drilled holes that you drilled in the shaft with the holes in the Spontoon head and apply some wood glue to the screws and screw them in.



To assemble your MAA American Spontoon:

(A) You will need to saw off approximately 1 3/4 inches off of the tenon of the shaft. This will make the shaft fit more snugly to the head.



(B) Take the head and fit it tightly on to the shaft. Then use an

awl or scribe to mark the shaft through the pre-drilled holes in the head. After you have done this, remove the Spontoon head and drill a shallow hole using a 1/32" (approx.) drill bit. [Fig.2]

(C) When the hole has been drilled, you can put the Spontoon head back in place



(D) Line up the drilled holes that you drilled in the shaft with the holes in the Spontoon head and apply some wood glue to the screws and screw them in.
